Weed Membrane

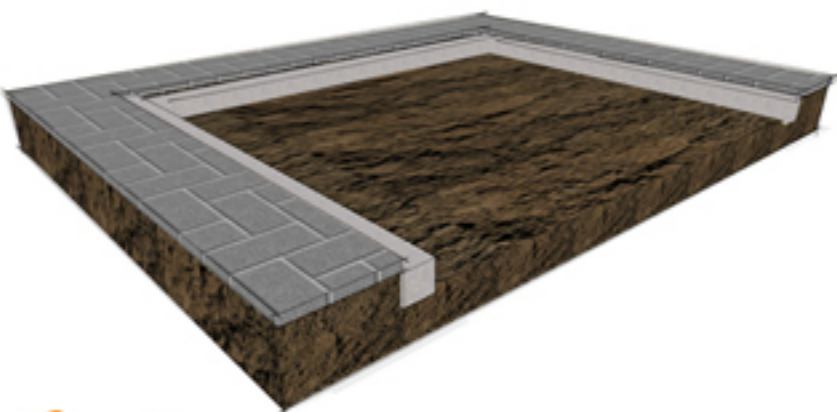
75mm sq.

### Grass Installation Soft Ground / Concrete Frame

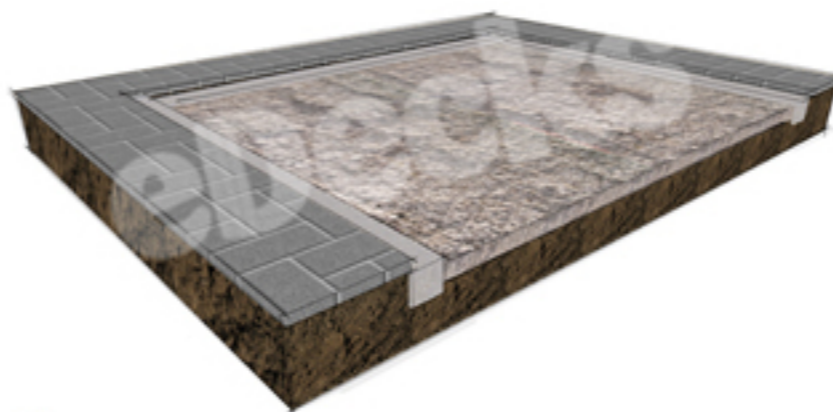
Limestone is a minimum of  
50mm compact

It's always a good idea when laying Artificial Grass on soft ground to have a solid edging to fasten the grass edging to...



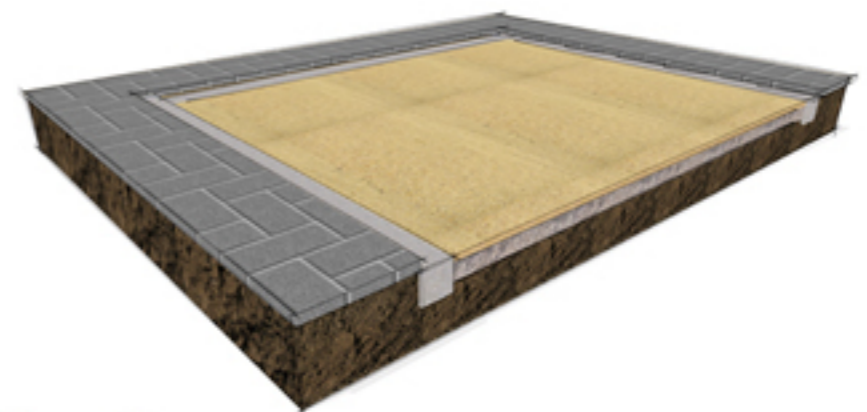
Step 1

Lay a 75mm x 75mm concrete strip all around the perimeter



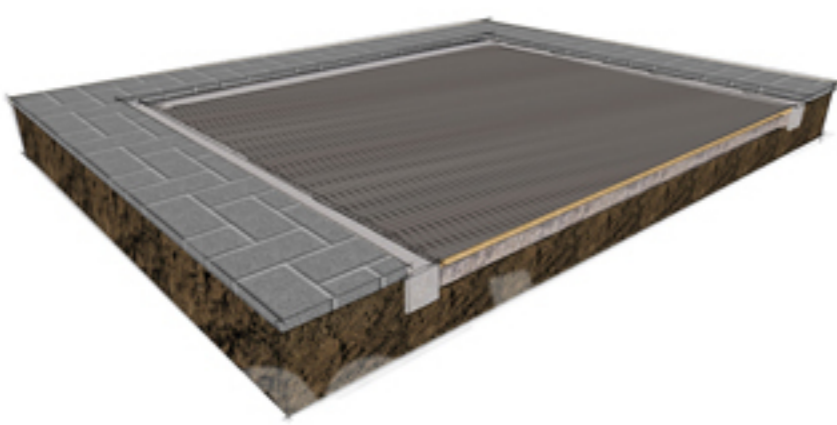
Step 2

Compact limestone, to a min of 50mm deep



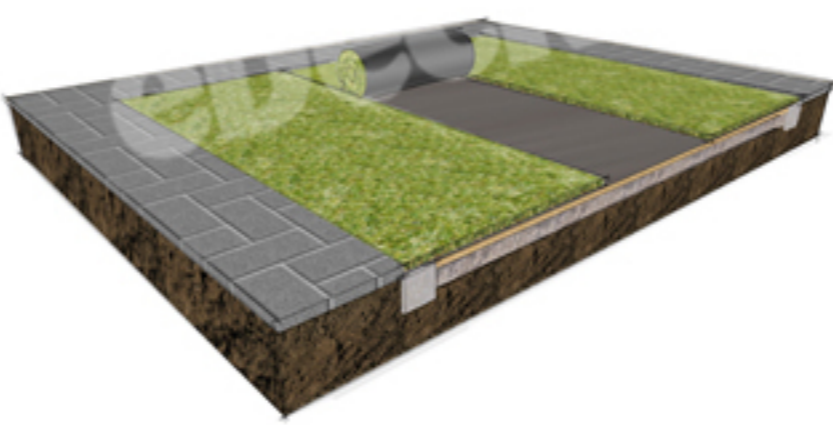
Step 3

Sharp Sand Blinding 10mm - 15mm



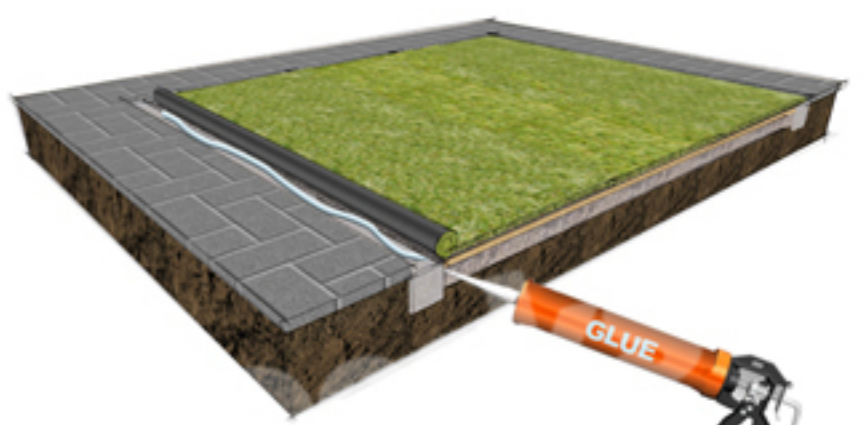
Step 4

Lay Weed Membrane



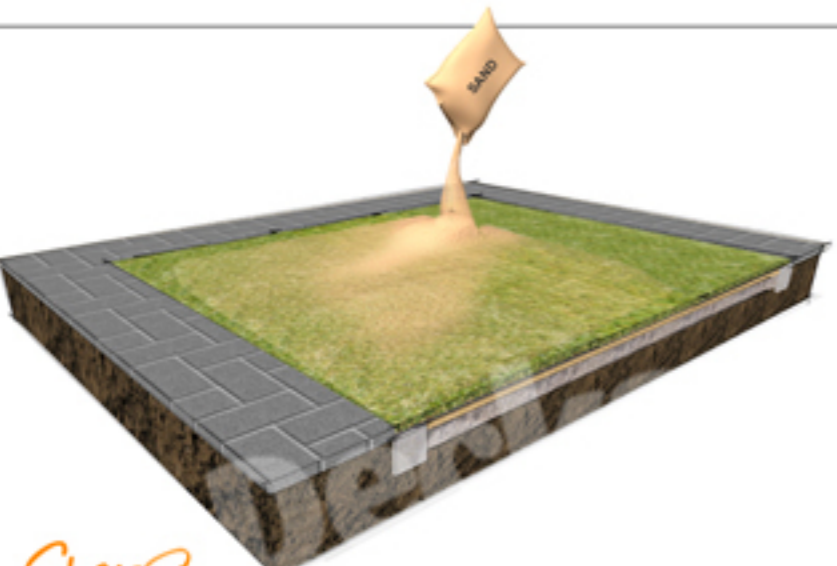
Step 5

Lay Artificial Grass



Step 6

Glue the grass to the concrete strip



Step 7

Kiln dried sand may be sprinkled over the surface of the grass to help hold it down but it's not essential



Step 8

Sit Back Relax and Enjoy your New Lawn!

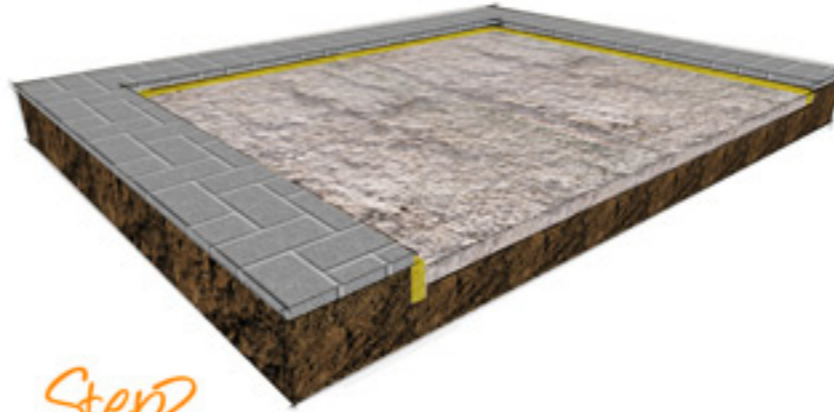

of 50mm deep



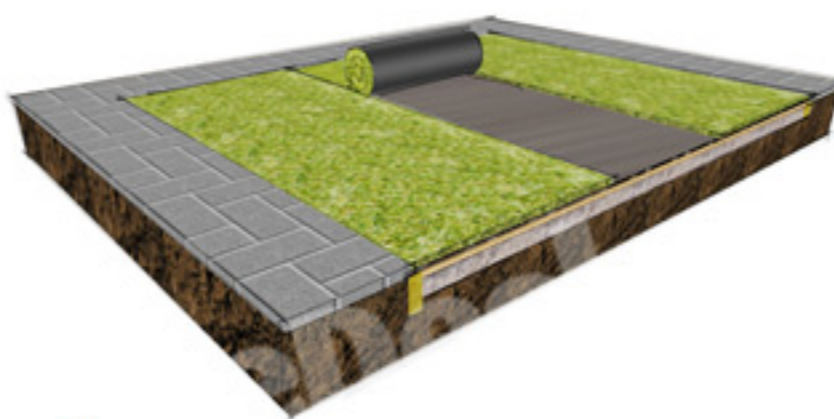
Step 3

10mm - 15mm



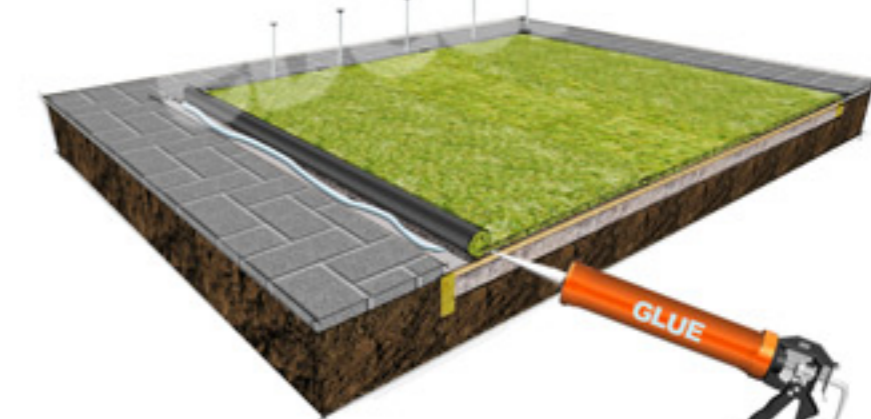

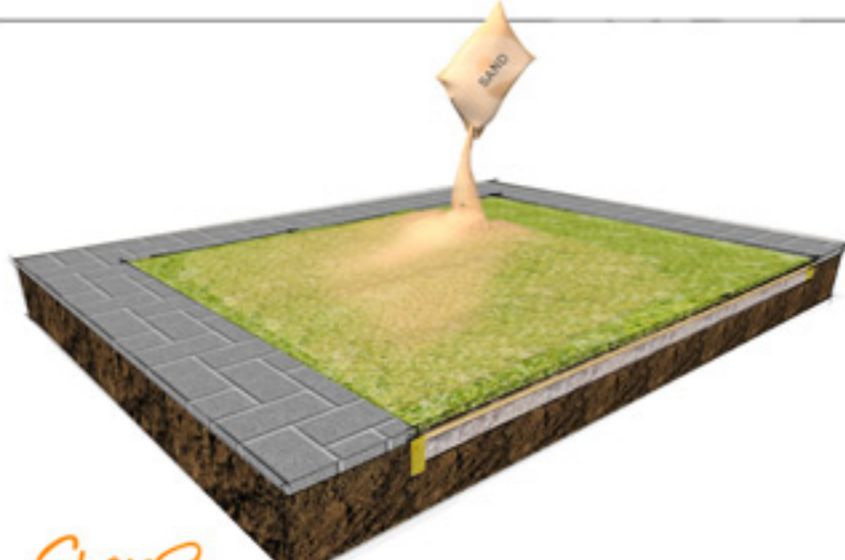
